Absorbing accurately what you see and hear is of paramount importance. Eye Spy reveals one particular training programme known as 60 SECONDS. Special classes are held in an endeavour to help employees and new recruits (students) develop inner skills, sharpen senses, heighten awareness. This usually only happens to those who will be actively engaged in field intelligence collection and after negotiating several layers of entry exams.

Intelligence collection in a limited time frame is quite an art and takes skill and much training... The intention is to enable operatives to see, gather and understand information without

necessarily seeking it: opportunism, initiative and the ability to remember are words which instantly spring to mind.

A MOST IMPORTANT SPY: MOSSAD CODENAME - THE ANGEL

In keeping with the shadowy life of one of the world's most important spies, a coroner in London couldn't decide how Egyptian billionaire and long-time suspected Mossad spy, Dr Ashraf Marwan, met his end in June 2007. Ashraf's body was found on the pavement beneath his fourth-floor luxury London flat by a passer-by. Many in the intelligence community believe his death has all the hallmarks of a murder made to look like suicide. However, there is still great uncertainty, and if this is the case, who was behind his assassination?

MOSCOW'S ILLEGALS: THE SVR CONTACT GROUP



On 9 June 2010, an American airline charter carrying 10 members of a US-based Russian spy ring flew into Vienna. At the same time, a jet from Moscow arrived carrying four Russians, all of whom, at one time or another, reportedly worked for American or British Intelligence. The group included the very important MI6 agent, Sergei Skripal, a former GRU (military intelligence) officer and SVR Colonel and CIA agent, Aleksandr Zaporozhsky. Skripal and Zaporozhsky, according to Moscow, betrayed the names of several Russian agents...

The speed in which the spy ring was despatched, the actual operatives and numerous other "murky" goings-on are examined in this fascinating feature with input from CIA counter-espionage...

THE SVR-MI6 INTELLIGENCE WAR



Most intelligence watchers believe America fared better in terms of the spy swap, though some analysts say that unless the four persons freed to the West retained a few "intel gems", neither side won. Another consideration is that the CIA has lost a valuable channel to direct disinformation via the Russian agents to Moscow.

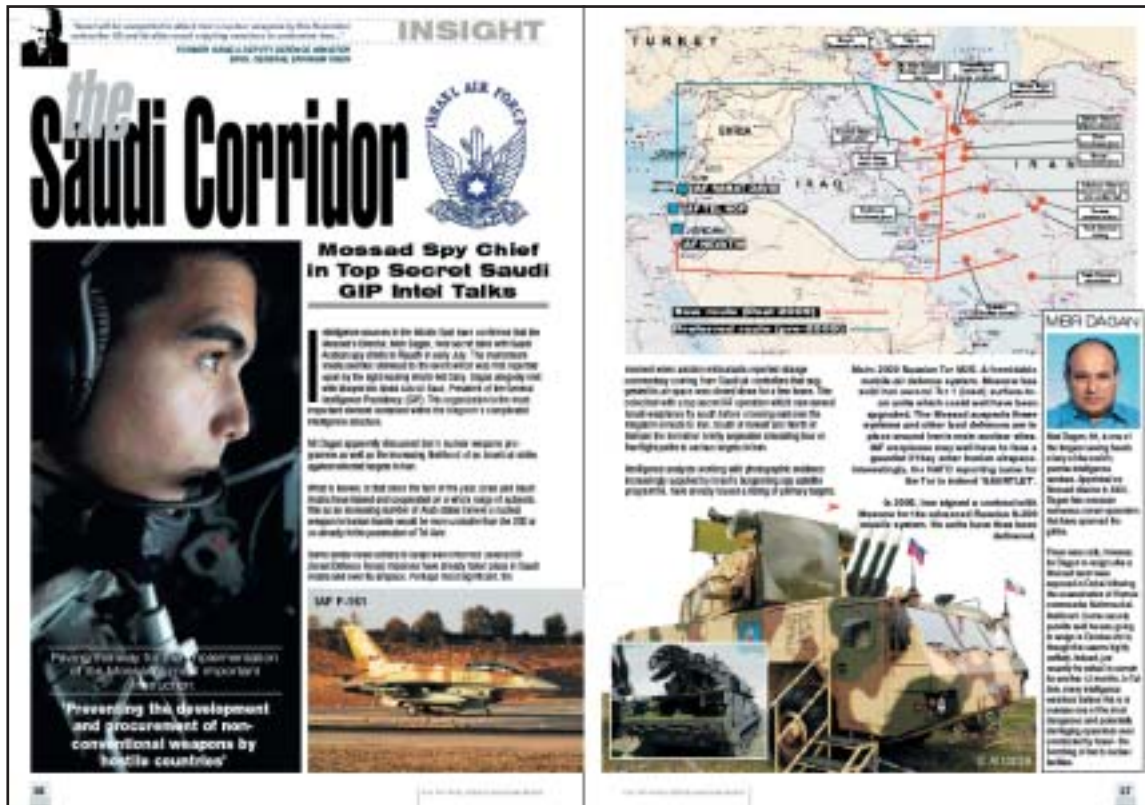

Iranian Intelligence has long claimed nuclear scientist, Shahram Amiri 32, was kidnapped by a tri-party undercover unit in May 2009, made up of CIA, Saudi Arabian Intelligence and Mossad operatives. LOCKERBIE: SUSPICIOUS MINDS



There remains concern in certain corners of Washington about the release of Abdelbaset al-Megrahi, the Libyan JSO (Jamahiriya Security Organisation) intelligence officer who helped place a bomb on board Pan Am Flight 103 in 1988. Some people believe he is but a pawn in a shadowy scheme to secure lucrative trade deals with Tripoli. However, negotiations to bring Libya "out of the cold", create new business platforms and a joint undercover intelligence effort to tackle al-Qaida, go back over a decade. But is the release of Al-Megrahi really linked to an oil deal with Libya?

When the Scottish Government sanctioned the release of Abdelbaset al-Megrahi on "compassionate grounds" last August, most people and ministers agreed it was a serious mistake. Al-Megrahi was supposedly on "death's door" and had but a few weeks to live. Intelligence officials were powerless to act, so too Downing Street, though ousted premier Gordon Brown's silence was deafening.

TOP SECRET AMERICA



US broadsheet shakes the intelligence tree" as it tries to calculate the size and purpose of the American Intel Community (IC)...

Around 100 years ago, Britain's fledgling Secret Intelligence Bureau had a couple of dozen employees, a small office in Westminster, one kettle, and a budget of less than £10,000 per annum. That money paid wages, rent, bills, tea, and yes, funded agency work. One hundred years later, and just across the 'Pond', details are starting to emerge of the enormous scale of America's burgeoning intelligence system. The statistics, if accurate, are quite staggering.

For the best part of two years, a small team of journalists from *The Washington Post* have methodically researched the US IC in an attempt to find out just how big it is, and has it made America safer (since 9/11)? Now, besides the known 16 premier agencies and dozens of various military/civilian elements in the armed forces, the paper has traced over 1250 government organisations and almost 2,000 private concerns that are threaded to the US IC.

Eye Spy looks at the data and finds one or two "facts" that simply don't up... and is there a secret agenda behind the newspaper's colossal investigation?
