

TO ASK \$1,000,000 FOR JEWS.

Appeal Will Be Made in 1,000 Synagogues on Wednesday.

An appeal for a fund of \$1,000,000 to alleviate the suffering of Jews in the European war zones will be made in 1,000 synagogues on Wednesday, or Yom Kippur, the Jewish Day of Atonement. The American Jewish Relief Committee said that all money contributed to the fund would be used to aid in the relief of the 3,000,000 Jews driven from their homes by the war, because the expenses of the campaign were to be paid by one contributor. The committee sent out this appeal:

"In order that the \$10,000,000 pledged by the Jews of this country be forthcoming it is of vital importance to the Jews of this city to come forward as never before to meet the needs of our stricken brethren abroad whose suffering is unparalleled in history. Untold thousands are suffering the misery of hunger, homelessness and nakedness. With the approach of Winter their privations become greater and greater and unless the \$10,000,000 originally pledged is realized before November of this year deaths from hunger and exposure will be recorded weekly by the thousands. We cannot help the men in the trenches or at the front, but the aged and infirm, the women, children, and babies at home must be saved if the Jewish race is to survive the terrible holocaust of the world war."
