


## **Desktop Charger**

for 4-Watt Wireless Paging System (Cat. No. 17-6023) and Tone/Vibration Paging Receiver (Cat. No. 17-6024)















Your RadioShack 17-6025 Desktop Charger is specially designed for use with the 4-Watt Wireless Paging System (Cat. No. 17-6023) and Tone/Vibration Paging Receiver (Cat. No. 17-6024). You can charge rechargeable batteries (sold separately) without removing them from the receiver by placing the receiver in one of the charger's slots. The batteries recharge fully in about 14 hours.

Your charger includes these features:

Ni-Cd/Ni-MH Battery Charging Switch
— lets you charge either Ni-Cd or Ni-MH batteries.

**6 Charging Slots** — let you charge up to six receivers at the same time.


**Automatic Charging** — detects the pager and automatically begins charging when you place the pager in the slot.

**Overnight Charging Timer** — automatically stops charging after 14–16 hours.

**Charging Indicator** — lights red while charging is in progress and green when charging is complete.


#### **CONNECTING POWER**

Plug one end of the power cord into the **9V DC** jack on the back of the charger. Plug the power adapter into a standard AC outlet.



## SELECTING THE BATTERY TYPE

Before charging batteries, you must select the type of battery to be charged. Slide the **Ni-Cd/Ni-MH** switch on the charger to **Ni-Cd** for nickel-cadmium batteries, or **Ni-MH** for nickel-metal hydride batteries.



#### Note:

- Do not mix different types of batteries or rechargeable batteries of different capacities in the charger.
- Do not charge Ni-Cd batteries with Ni-Cd/Ni-MH set to Ni-MH. Doing so could damage the batteries and the pager.






Your charger is specially designed for use with the RadioShack Paging Receiver (sold separately as Cat. No. 17-6024). When the pager's batteries are low and you press **ON/OFF**, **b** appears on the pager's display, and the pager beeps every 15 seconds.

Follow these steps to recharge batteries:

- Slide the ALKALINE/RECHARGE-ABLE switch inside the pager's battery compartment to RECHARGE-ABLE.
- Place the pager (with Ni-Cd or Ni-MH batteries installed) in one of the charger's slots. The charging indicator lights green, then red.



3. Charge the batteries for 14–16 hours. The charging indicator lights green when charging is completed.

#### Notes:

• Charge a pager only when its batteries are low.

 Do not remove and insert the pager into the slot during charging. Doing so could damage the batteries and the pager.

#### **CARE**

To enjoy your Desktop Charger for a long time:

- Keep the charger dry. If it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.
- Use and store the charger only in normal temperature environments.
- Handle the charger gently and carefully. Don't drop it.
- Keep the charger away from dust and dirt.
- Wipe the charger with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.

Modifying or tampering with the charger's internal components can cause a malfunction and invalidate its warranty. If your charger is not performing as it should, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance.
